**Boat Lift Application** 

Dear Fellow Member,

This application is in response to your request for permission to install a boat lift in your assigned slip. We require the following information and documentation before you can proceed:

- 1. Provide the Board with the following items in order to obtain preliminary approval:
  - a. Your lift needs to comply with the Rules and Regulations posted on the VSYA website, in addition to the following rules listed below:
    - Any new pilings (if applicable) cannot be installed more than 3' behind the existing pilings
    - No lifts can be attached to the sea wall or existing pilings
    - If proposed lift requires 220V, the member is responsible to pay for the installation of new wiring and provide documentation of liability insurance releasing VSYA from all liability
    - Locations on the curves within the marina, may require additional restrictions on length and width
    - Maximum lift capacity is 18,000 lbs.
  - b. Sketch showing how the proposed lift will fit within the footprint of the slip and where any additional pilings will be located (if applicable)
  - c. Complete specifications/engineering drawings and provide brochures of the proposed lift
  - d. Name and contact information of installer/provider and documentation of liability insurance releasing VSYA from all liability
  - e. Submit current proof of vessel insurance (minimum of \$300,000 liability coverage)
  - f. Signed Boat Lift Application (see below)
  - g. All items listed above to be submitted via email to Frank Barchiese and Sarah Campbell
- 2. Once the Board has provided preliminary approval, you will need to obtain approval/permit(s) from the following agencies:
  - a. Department of Environmental Protection (if applicable)
  - b. Army Corp. of Engineers (if applicable)
  - c. The Village of Islamorada
- 3. After receiving the required permit(s), you will need to forward these documents to Frank Barchiese and Sarah Campbell in order to receive final Board approval before the lift is installed.
- 4. If the installation of the proposed lift does not comply with what was approved by the Board, then the member will be required to make the necessary changes to the lift and/or pilings at their own expense.

Your signature on this application is your personal acceptance of any and all liability that may occur as a result of installation and operation of your boat lift.
